QUILT ENTRY GENERAL RULES

1. Entries for the quilt exhibition are limited to members of the Amoskeag Quilters' Guild.
 - a. Quilt must be made a minimum of 50% by the guild member.
2. Entries must have been completed within the last 10 years (except antique quilts).
 - a. Quilts must not have been previously exhibited at an Amoskeag Quilters' Guild exhibit.
3. All entries must be made of fabric and quilt show guests will select a "Viewer's Choice" in each category based on overall appearance, design and workmanship.
4. There is no minimum or maximum size requirement.
5. Quilter will select the proper category for their entry based on the following categories:
Bed Quilt Modern Quilt Wearable Art Quilt
Group Quilt Wall quilt/Miniature
6. Guild members can choose to enter a quilt into the following Special Exhibits:
Mystery Quilt Border Beauty/Challenge Quilt Embroidery/Redwork
7. All works must be submitted ready for display.
 - a. All quilts, with the exception of antique quilts, should have a minimum 6" pocketed sleeve sewn across the back of the quilt.
 - b. Clothing must be submitted with stands or some method of displaying them.
8. Each entry must have a label. When looking at the back of the quilt, the label should be located on the lower left-hand corner with contain the following information:
 - a. Name of Creator(s)
 - b. Title of Work
9. Each Entry must be delivered to the quilt show on Friday evening no later than 7:00 pm.
10. No quilt will be withdrawn prior to close of the quilt show.
 - a. Quilts can be picked up on Sunday between 4:45 pm and 5:30 pm.
 - b. You must have the proper paperwork to take possession of the quilt.
 - c. NO quilt will be returned to a person other than the quilt owner unless written permission is received. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS.
11. Security will be provided by guild members during the exhibit.
 - a. Quilts are NOT covered by the AQG Insurance Policy.
 - b. Should you care to obtain insurance, do so through your home owners/renters insurance.
